- We have an online booking system on our website allowing students to self-refer as well as school officials to book for them.
- We are providing bus vouchers again this year for those students who will need transportation to and/or from the boutique on their shopping day.

The process for both referral types is outlined in this packet.

Please note the appointments are on a first come, first served basis. We encourage you to make referrals or book online as soon as possible. If you have a group of 6 or more girls on a single day, it's helpful to contact us in advance for planning purposes. Shopping Days for special needs students will be by Appointment Only determined by their specific needs and challenges that need to be addressed.

We have over 3,500 gorgeous dresses in stock – in countless styles, colors and designs – and in sizes 0 to 34. We can't wait to open our doors for the 2024 Shopping Season!

#### REFERRAL FORM - 2024 PROM SEASON

Each student receives a dress, shoes, purse, and 2 pieces of jewelry at no cost. <u>The student must be enrolled in and attending an accredited state high school, or a home education program approved by a public school district</u>. The student must have current financial or personal need as confirmed by School Personnel or Social Worker.

#### School Personnel or Social Worker:

- 1. Refer only students who are unable to attend prom without our assistance.
- 2. Send this form to <a href="mailto:info@kenziescloset.org">info@kenziescloset.org</a> or complete the online registration form at <a href="https://www.kenziescloset.org">www.kenziescloset.org</a>.
- 3. After we receive a referral, Kenzie's CLOSET will:
  - a. Send a confirmation to the contact information provided on the form.
  - b. Provide you a list of students from your school who we have confirmed for shopping. If you do not receive a confirmation or have any questions, please let us know!

<u>Student</u>: Please bring: A photo ID (school ID, Driver's license, report card, bus pass, etc.).

- 1. Arrive between the hours of 3-4:00 pm during our traditional after school shopping dates.
- 2. If you can't make it to your appointment, please contact us as soon as possible at 513-533-7766, cancel your appointment online or email at info@kenziescloset.org. Appointments are rescheduled at our discretion and on a first come, first served basis.
- **3.** Because of space limitations, students may bring **ONLY ONE ADULT** into the building. Student shoppers under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 4. Your accompanying adult will wait for you in our lobby area; they will not be permitted to enter the shopping area. You will be paired with a personal shopper who will assist you.
- 5. No children under the age of 13 are permitted in Kenzie's CLOSET. No exceptions.
- 6. Parking is available in a pay parking lot behind our building, or on the street with parking meters.

### 2024 PROM POLICY & PROCEDURES

#### Requirements to receive FREE prom attire at Kenzie's CLOSET

- The student must be enrolled in and attending an accredited state high school, or a home education program approved by a public school district.
- The student must be have current financial or personal need as confirmed by School Personnel or Social Worker.
- Identification with a Photo, such as School ID card, driver's license, bus pass, etc.or proof of student status (school schedule, report card, transcript, written school district approval for home education program, etc.).
- Students under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult on their shopping day.

#### What is the Referral process?

- Student contacts their school counselor, psychologist, school administrator, or social worker for a referral form.
- Student/Parent/ Guardian completes the referral form and returns to Administrator.
- The school Administrator will verify financial need and submit the referral form directly to Kenzie's CLOSET via online form or email. Kenzie's CLOSET will email a response with a confirmation appointment date and time to the student. We will email an "Appointment Reminder" to the Administrator/student.
- Student must bring their "Appointment Reminder" Form (either printed or viewable on a phone) and photo ID to their appointment.

#### What is the Online Booking process?

- A student may go online to our Shopping Calendar and select a date, complete the form and provide the information needed to book.
- We will verify the student's eligibility with the school once we receive the booking and coordinate any final details and/or transportation needs.

#### Shopping Day Guidelines

- Our door opens at 3:00 pm and the last girl is admitted at 4:00 pm.
- If you can't make it to your appointment, contact us more than 24 hours before appointment at 513-533-7766 or email at <a href="mailto:info@kenziescloset.org">info@kenziescloset.org</a>. Appointments are rescheduled at our discretion.
- No food, drink, or children under the age of 13 are permitted in Kenzie's CLOSET.
- Student walk-ins cannot be accepted. You must have an appointment.
- Because of space limitations, students may bring ONLY ONE adult into the building. Your accompanying adult will wait for you in our lobby area; they will not be permitted to enter the shopping area.

<u>Please Note</u>: Kenzie's CLOSET staff and volunteers work hard to ensure a welcoming, respectful, and safe environment for your students' shopping day. We reserve the right to refuse admission to any student and/or accompanying adult who cannot abide by the written rules as determined by the sole discretion of Kenzie's Closet.



#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### 1. How do I apply?

You may apply with our online booking system to self-refer, use our traditional referral packet, or visit us online at www.kenziescloset.org

#### 2. Can I apply myself or how does this work?

You may apply yourself with our self-referral form. We will verify the information with your school administrator or social worker and send you a confirmation.

#### 3. How do I know I am eligible?

Any high school girl attending an accredited high school or home school attached to a public school who demonstrates a financial or personal need is eligible to shop at Kenzie's Closet.

#### 4. Does it cost me anything?

There is no cost to you.

#### 5. What do I receive on Shopping Day?

You will receive a dress (on-site alterations will be available if needed), 2 pieces of jewelry, a purse and a new pair of shoes.

#### 6. How does it work?

You will arrive at the boutique on your scheduled shopping day and assigned a personal shopper for the day. Your personal shopper will help you find the dress of your dreams.

#### 7. Do I get to keep my outfit?

Yes, the outfit and accessories are yours to keep.

#### 8. Do I get to take it with me the same day I am there?

You may take it with you on the same day unless longer than normal alterations are needed.

#### 9. Do you have transportation/How do I get there?

We are providing day Metro passes to students free of charge. We also have parking available behind our building or metered street parking. Our address is 2010 Madison Road, Lower Level, Cincinnati, Ohio, 45208. We are located in O'Bryonville on the bus route.

#### 10. Can I bring someone with me?

Yes, you may bring one person with you. If you are under the age of 18, you must be accompanied by an adult. No one under the age of 13 is permitted in the boutique.

#### 11. What if I can't make it that day? Can I reschedule?

Please contact the office at 513-533-7766, cancel online or email <u>admin@kenziescloset.org</u>. We will do our best to reschedule you for another shopping day based on availability.

#### 12. Can I donate my dress back to Kenzie's Closet?

Yes, you may donate back to Kenzie's Closet. Donations can be dropped off at Appearance Plus at 3505 Erie Avenue Cincinnati, Ohio 45208 or Appearance Plus at 6812 Clough Pike Cincinnati, Ohio 45244 or Shop Charbon at 5671 Rapid Run Road Cincinnati, Ohio 45238. Continue to check www.kenziescloset.org for other locations to be added.

#### 13. What happens during bad weather or snow days?

In the event of inclement weather, we will reschedule your day. Kenzie's Closet will advertise on all local news stations and our website.

#### 1. How do I sign up?

Please sign up on our website www.kenziescloset.org. Shopping days and times are on the website. If you have a large group who would like to volunteer together, please contact heather@kenziescloset.org and we will schedule you for a day.

#### 2. What do I wear?

You will be given a new Kenzie's closet shirt to wear upon your arrival. This is yours to keep and we ask you wear it each time you volunteer.

#### 3. What if I can't make it the day I signed up?

Please email heather@kenziescloset.org or call the boutique at 513-533-7766 as soon as you know you cannot keep your volunteer shift. If additional shifts are available, you are welcome to reschedule.

#### 4. How does this work?

You will arrive in the boutique 15 minutes before your scheduled time. We will provide you with some instructions We will assign you to a girl to help her find her dream dress, shoes and bling for her big day.

# Student Scholarship

# **GUIDELINES & INFORMATION**

APPLICATION: www.kenziescloset.org

Kenzie's Closet invites any female high school student who has shopped at our boutique to apply for this award. Qualifying students must be graduating in the current graduating year of application). Kenzie's Closet is pleased to be awarding a \$1,000 Scholarship to any student who is continuing their education in one of the following ways:

- 1. Entering a trade school
- 2. Entering a community college
- 3. Entering a 4-year college or university

The winner will be chosen based on their responses to the questions in the application, not their GPA. The applicant in each category who best embodies the spirit of inclusion, empowerment and community giving of Kenzie's Closet will be given the scholarship award. Only one award will be given to a student. The award winner will be featured on our website and in the Kenzie's Closet boutique reception space for the year following their scholarship award. The scholarship award check will be mailed directly to the scholarship recipient's school after final selection is announced.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Applicant must be a female high school student in Grade 12 and graduating in 2024.
- Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better and intends to pursue post-secondary education (trade school, community college or 4-year college/university).
- Applicant may not be a family member or the child/grandchild of a current staff member or board member.
- Application, along with an unofficial transcript, should be submitted online or emailed to <u>info@kenziescloset.org</u> by midnight on April 1.
- Winner must be available to receive the award in person. If there are financial or personal circumstances that make this impossible, please notify Kenzie's Closet (info@kenziescloset.org) prior to completing the application.
- Winner agrees to be interviewed, photographed and/or videotaped by Kenzie's Closet, as well as any other media outlet(s). If the winner is under 18 years old, a parent or guardian must grant permission for the interview(s).

The application deadline is midnight on April 1, 2024.
